The **Northern New Jersey Local** hosted the first SPUSA “**Red November**” **Organizing Conference** in Newark New Jersey on Sunday November 10th.

The Conference was a regional conference endorsed by the New York City, Capital District NY and Central NJ Locals and over 30 members and supporters attended a full day of presentations and discussion.



The event was MCd by Northern NJ member Lark Lo and speakers included Brian Powers of Revolution Radio, Sara Cullinane of Make the Road NJ and Danielle Williams of the Palestinian Animal League with discussion led by Northern NJ members.

The event also had a “guest appearance” by Daryle Lamont Jenkins of One Peoples Project.

Election Wrap Up

The Socialist Party USA had candidates (nominated or endorsed) across the country.

In **Maine** Socialist Party nominees **Maia Dendinger** secured **1,109 votes** (7%) in a 3-way race for Maine State Senate District 5 and **Seth Braun** secured **2,062 votes** (7.9%) in a 7-way race (3 seats) for Bangor City Council.

In **New York**, Socialist Party-endorsed candidate **Howie Hawkins** secured **95,864 votes** (1.7%) for Governor.

In **New Jersey**, SPUSA nominee **Pat Noble** was **re-elected** to the Red Bank Regional Board of Education with 2,436 votes and SPUSA endorsed candidate **Diane Moxley** received **2,505 votes** (0.8%) for US Congress NJ-7.

In **West Virginia**, SPUSA nominee **Elliott Pritt** secured **2,358 votes** (6%) in a 7-way race for West Virginia State House of Delegates District 32.

In **Michigan**, Socialist Party nominee **Matt Kuehnel** secured **999 votes** (3.31%) in a 3-way race for Michigan State Representative District 22

In **California**, Socialist Party-endorsed candidate **Kenneth Mejia** secured **26,160 votes** (26%) for US Congress CA-34

The students came with their questions, with much of their focus on climate change and what a transition to socialism might look like.

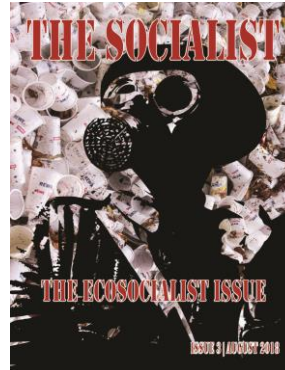
